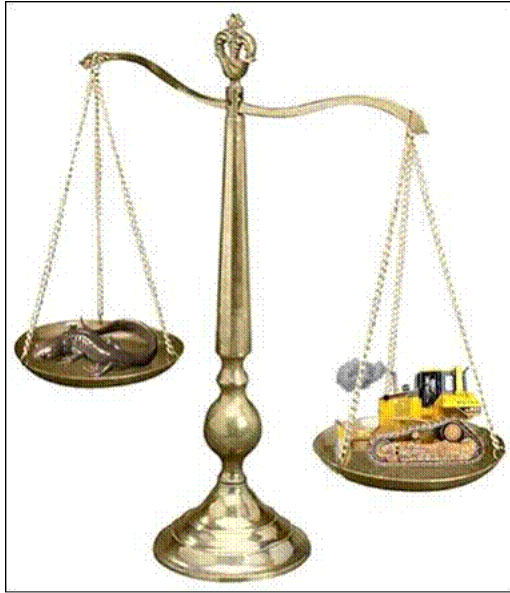

### Endangered Species Act: Out of Balance

The scales are tipping against species at risk in our province. Learn how to support strong endangered species legislation. Help balance the scales.

The Save Ontario's Species (SOS) Coalition needs your help. Though we hailed Ontario's Endangered Species Act (ESA) as a gold standard in species protection when it was passed, alarming potential loopholes have come to light. Without the broad support of the public,

endangered species in Ontario may not receive the protection they need.

**Help us protect Ontario's species and conserve biodiversity in the province!**
