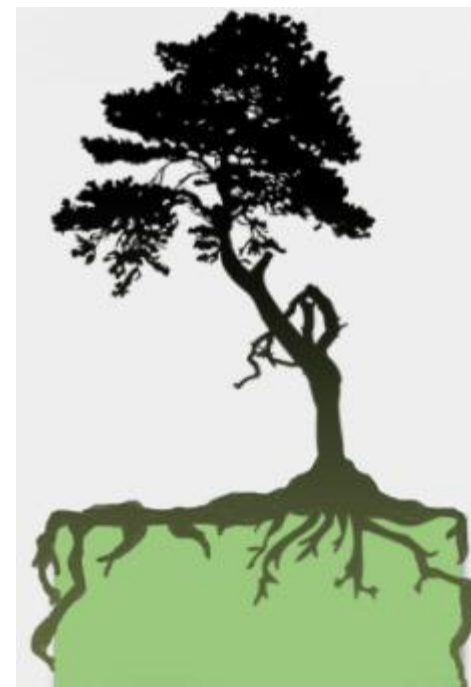
At Home on Hudson's Bay
