**New Threat to Woodland Caribou**

Woodland caribou are facing a new threat in Ontario - Hydro One is planning to build a 430km transmission line from the Nipigon area to Pickle Lake, alongside the northern part of Wabakimi Provincial Park.

If this new line goes through, it will harm the already threatened woodland caribou and their intact Boreal Forest home. CPAWS Wildlands League is asking Hydro One to propose alternative routes – such as, along existing paved roads or railways – which would be better for the health of this beautiful wilderness area and for the survival of woodland caribou.

Please take a moment and send a letter to Hydro One encouraging them to examine alternatives.
