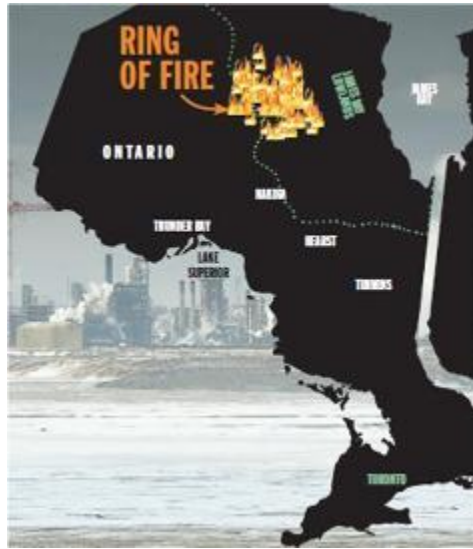

Ring of Fire mining threatens caribou habitat and wild rivers

Starting today, Wildlands League is taking over the [Metro news website](#) for a week. We are putting Ontario on notice. Despite commitments to 'get it right' with proposed mining in the Ring of

Fire, the province has ignored scientists, First Nations, public interest groups and individual Canadians, like you, who have all demanded a comprehensive regional assessment . Without a plan worthy of Ontario's "largest mining development in a century", great rivers will be put at risk, caribou habitat will be sacrificed and the global cooling benefits of peatlands will be compromised.

Unless Ontario steps up and puts in place a long term ecosystem-based plan for the region with First Nations, it runs the risk of repeating the mistakes of projects like the tar sands.
